

The Ultimate Smores Recipe

As far back as we can remember the Smore has been a tradition during our camping adventures. For those who are unfamiliar with the delicious Smore it is basically toasted marshmallow and chocolate, sandwiched between two graham crackers. The idea is after toasting the marshmallow you quickly assemble the sandwich with hopes that the hot marshmallow melts the chocolate to a consistency that allows the marshmallow and chocolate join together become one. Although this method is tasty it is hit and miss for the actual perfect consistency.

What we have done at River Rippers Fishing Lures is come up with a recipe that creates the Ultimate Smore to enhance your camping experience.

You Will Need

1. Campfire
2. Marshmallows
3. Chocolate (Swoops work the best for this as they are nice and thin and melt very easily)
4. Graham crackers
5. Camp Cooker Sandwich Maker (ours was made by Cochlan's and was bought at Canadian Tire)
6. Marshmallow roasting stick

Preparation Instructions

1. Place empty sandwich maker into fire to heat it up. A couple minutes per side will do. Put sandwich maker some place safe when you remove it so the little ones do not grab it and burn themselves.
2. Toast marshmallow to a golden brown.
3. Assemble the Smore in this order: graham cracker, chocolate, toasted marshmallow, graham cracker
4. Place the Smore into Sandwich Maker and let it sit in there until chocolate has melted. A couple of minutes will do. Remember that the Sandwich Maker's purpose is to help the hot marshmallow melt the chocolate so you don't want the sandwich maker too hot.
5. Eat it.
